



DHI record services help dairy producers manage records for use in making better management decisions. Test day includes the collection of milk samples, as well as updating and correcting records. Samples are tested for butterfat, protein, and Somatic Cell Count (SCC). Farms can also choose to add additional analyses like Milk Urea Nitrogen (MUN), pregnancy, Johne's, and Bovine Viral Diarrhea (BVD).

There is no requirement for how often farms chose to test their herds. You can chose to test 4 times a year or every other month, though most farms chose to test monthly. The more frequently you test, the more valuable the service will be.

With regular DHI service, farms can:

- Reduce somatic cell count and increase premiums
- Improve udder health
- Increase daily milk production
- Improve time management
- Reduce feed costs
