## Why celebrate forage?

- **1.** Forages cover about 55% of the land area in the U.S.
- 2. Forages are defined as the edible parts of plants that provide feed for grazing animals or that can be harvested for feeding.
- **3.** Forages support grazing livestock and wildlife habitat, enhance crop diversity, and provide ecosystem services to society.
- **4.** There are about 14,000 species of grass in the United States.
- **5.** One acre of forage protects around 2 million pounds of soil.
- **6.** Legume forages like alfalfa and clover add nitrogen to the soil, reducing the need for added fertilizer.
- 7. Forage crops are an important source of pollen and nectar for honeybees.
